### Non Violent Crisis Intervention

Allen Craig. SCACL is pleased to partner with PRACL to offer this training.

The *Nonviolent Crisis Intervention*<sup>®</sup> training program is a holistic behavior management system based on the philosophy of providing the best *Care, Welfare, Safety, and Security*<sup>SM</sup> for staff and those in their care, even during the most violent moments. The program focuses on preventing disruptive behavior by communicating with individuals respectfully and with concern for their well-being. The program teaches physical interventions only as a last resort—when an individual presents an imminent danger to self or others—and all physical interventions taught are designed to be non harmful, non invasive, and to maintain the individual's dignity. Follow-up debriefing strategies are also key components of the training program.
