Supper Club will be held only once in on the June 19th – It will be a special Supper Club – We will be catering for the AGM, and having pizza.

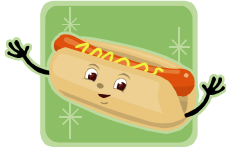

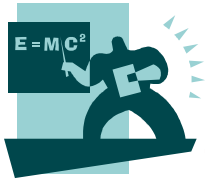
Celebrate Fathers Day at SCACL with a Banana Split

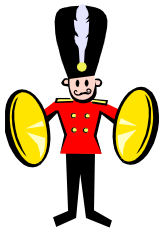
SCACL Mermaid Offices to Expand
